
Battery Access Clearance

Bracket Mounting Depth: Access to the battery compartment relies on the "slide-out", battery access feature of left shade bracket.








Battery Sleeve Removal/Insertion:

Batteries are housed in a sleeve that fits inside the EDU. Removal and insertion of the sleeve requires clearance to end walls and other window-adjacent objects or structures.

The quantity of batteries required varies with shade configuration and will be indicated on battery sleeve.



Close-quarters Installations:

When the installation location does not allow the battery sleeve clearances shown above, the shade must be uninstalled from the brackets to access the battery sleeve. Refer to installation guide for further instructions.



CEILING INSIDE MOUNT OR JAMB INSIDE MOUNT


To fully recess the shade, the window jamb must be at least 3.75 in (95 mm) deep for Type A brackets or 3.5 in (89 mm) deep for Type B brackets. Installation of the shade relies on the "slide-out" battery access feature of the shade brackets.


To install or remove the shade brackets, an additional clearance of 3.75 in (95 mm) for Type A brackets or 3.5 in (89 mm) for Type B brackets is required in front of the shade.



CEILING MOUNT


Screws are driven through the top of the bracket into the blocking as shown.






JAMB MOUNT

Screws are driven through the side of the bracket into the blocking as shown. It is recommended that holes are drilled through the bracket before mounting. Flat head screws (not provided) are required for jamb mount.




OUTSIDE MOUNT ABOVE TRIM
